It is easy to install and maintain in commercial kitchens. The mesh filter can be easily cleaned and re-used or replaced. Microceptor's unique engineering ensures that the maintenance process is drip-free. As a failsafe, it has also been uniquely engineered to allow wastewater to by-pass the system in the event of a lapse in basic maintenance so that the sink can continue to be used during busy periods even though the sediment chamber is full.
